Safeguarding

Policy Statement

Any contractor or service provider who is assigned to carry out a service or complete work on site, must provide the nursery with up to date DBS information. If they are unable to do so, this will result in non-use of their service. This includes contractors & service providers who may need access to the building during working hours.

Contractors will not be left unattended in the building.

Alternatively, services will be carried out during evening and weekends when there are no children on the premises.

Any contractor or service provider who cannot provide a full DBS, will only be given access to the nursery with the permission of the Manager or Deputy, where a full risk assessment will have to be completed.

Due regard will be given to the 'Prevent' and GDPR Policy when undertaking any contractor's services.

This policy will be reviewed sooner than the policy date if any new information becomes available.

Covid 19

There will be no service providers or contractors allowed to enter the building.

For the emptying of feminine waste, we recognise that the bins will need to be emptied, we will take the bins to the door and have them emptied then bring them back in after wiping down with disinfectant.
