# Policy For The Health and Safety of Children and Staff during the Choronavirus Outbreak.

## Policy Statement

We have taken advice from our Early Years Consultants at Bolton's Startwell Centre, who advised us to contact the Community Infection Prevention and Control Team.

We had done this, and the advice we have been given is that any child, during this worrying time, who requires any form of temperature control medication should be kept off nursery until they are feeling much better.

Although at present, we do understand that any illness may not be related to the Coronavirus, the advice is that children should stay away from nursery while they are experiencing a temperature.

We will not be administering Calpol to children with temperatures, or indeed just because they may be unwell.

Any child with any temperature must remain absent from nursery until the temperature is under control without the addition of requiring any medication.

Any child developing a temperature whilst at nursery will be sent home.

I do understand that this may become inconvenient to you, please be reassured that we are displaying extremely high levels of infection control at the moment.
